2 ENROLLED, An Act,

Relating to the practice of deceptively obtaining a prescription for a controlled substance; to prohibit the practice of deceptively obtaining the same or a similar substance from two or more practitioners in a concurrent time period; to prescribe criminal penalties for that practice; and in connection therewith would have as its purpose or effect the requirement of a new or increased expenditure of local funds within the meaning of Amendment 621 of the Constitution of Alabama of 1901, now appearing as Section 111.05 of the Official Recompilation of the Constitution of Alabama of 1901, as amended.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

Section 1. (a) It is unlawful for any person to deceptively obtain a controlled substance, as defined in Section 20-2-2(4), Code of Alabama 1975, from a medical practitioner by intentionally and knowingly withholding information from the medical practitioner that the person has obtained a prescription for the same controlled substance or another controlled substance of similar therapeutic use in a concurrent time period from another medical practitioner. The unlawful activity is complete upon the delivery of the prescription to the patient and occurs at the location of the delivery.

1	(b) A violation of subsection (a) constitutes a
2	Class A misdemeanor punishable as prescribed by law.
3	(c) A person who commits a fourth or subsequent
4	violation of subsection (a) within a five-year period commits
5	a Class C felony.
6	Section 2. Although this bill would have as its
7	purpose or effect the requirement of a new or increased
8	expenditure of local funds, the bill is excluded from further
9	requirements and application under Amendment 621 because the
10	bill defines a new crime or amends the definition of an
11	existing crime.
12	Section 3. This act shall become effective on the
13	first day of the third month following its passage and

approval by the Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
